The Thomas sisters "mushed" (drove their dogs) 200 miles to Nome on one leg of their trip to Chemawa. They are from the Arctic Circle and are fine dog drivers. The Eshalt girls were in a shipwreck 30 miles from the Siberian coast and the passengers and crew were without food when rescued by the U. S. Revenue Cutter Bear.
