Boys' Intramural Basketball Begins

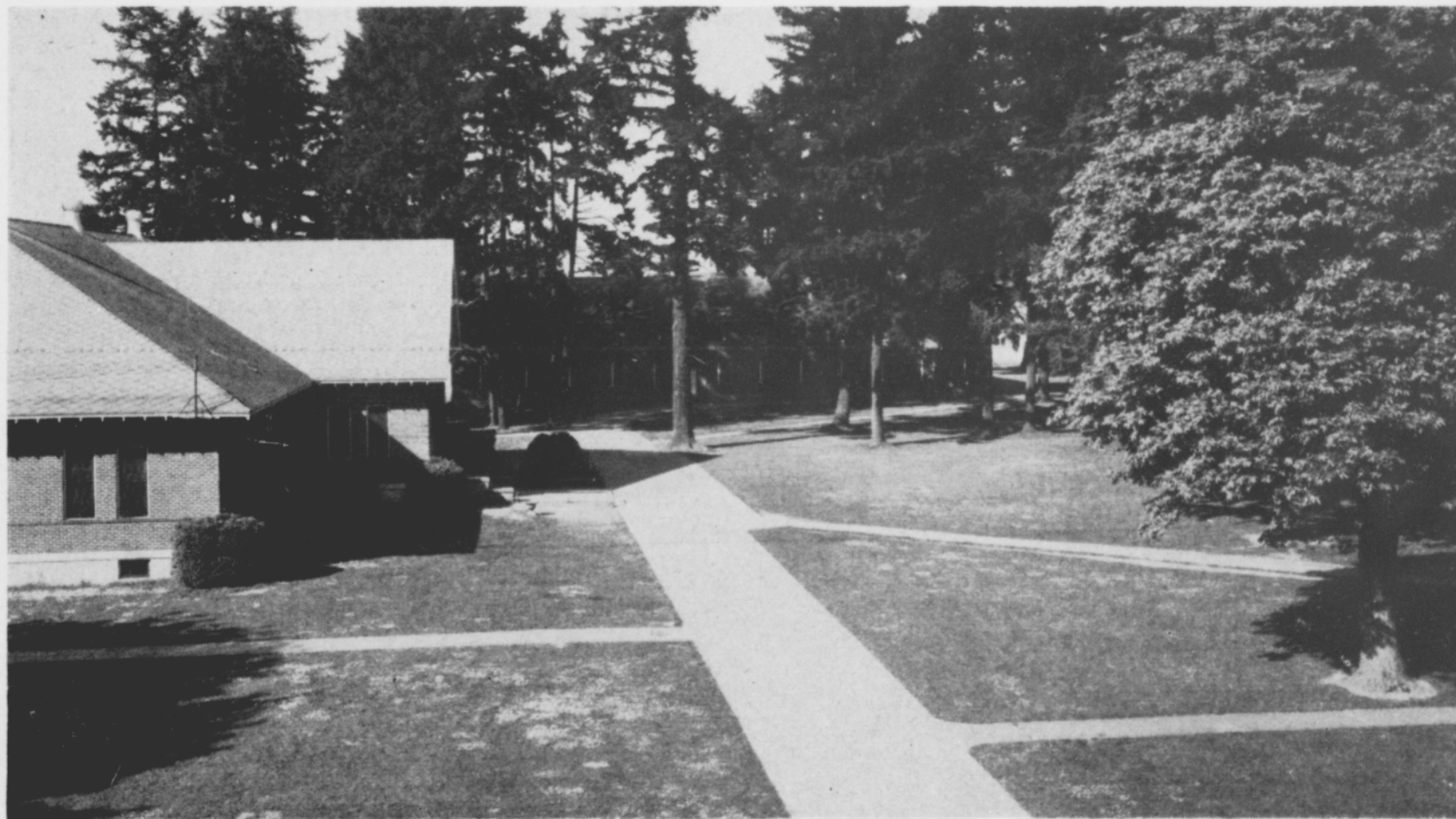
The boys of McNary Hall started their intramural basketball games, Oct. 8, with three leagues. As of Nov. 12, the league standings are as follows:
