

CHEMAWA HOSTS BAND CLINIC

On February 10, 1969, Chemawa hosted all of the Capital Conference schools for a Band Clinic. There were approximately 500 Band students from 14 schools and their directors on campus.

The Clinic was conducted by Dr. David Wallace and the Oregon College of Education Band.

The Clinic commenced at 10:00 a.m. with sections meeting in different rooms to discuss the different and many problems that face the players of each particular instrument of the Band. At 11:00 a.m. the emphasis was placed on ensemble playing and the literature available for ensembles. During the lunch hour, the O.C.E. Band and the guest directors had lunch in the Chemawa Dining Hall, while the visiting students ate their sack lunches in the gym. The 'Meteors', Chemawa's Rock Band, provided music for listening and dancing in the gym.

The session closed with a concert for all the Band students performed by the O.C.E. Band. The music program included a wide range of Band arrangements--from Bach (16th Century) to Hovanhess (20th Century).

Boys outnumber girls by 76, with 443 boys and 367 girls. There are 390 Alaskan boys and 324 Alaskan girls, 47 Navajo boys to 37 girls, and 6 boys and 6 girls from the Northwest.
