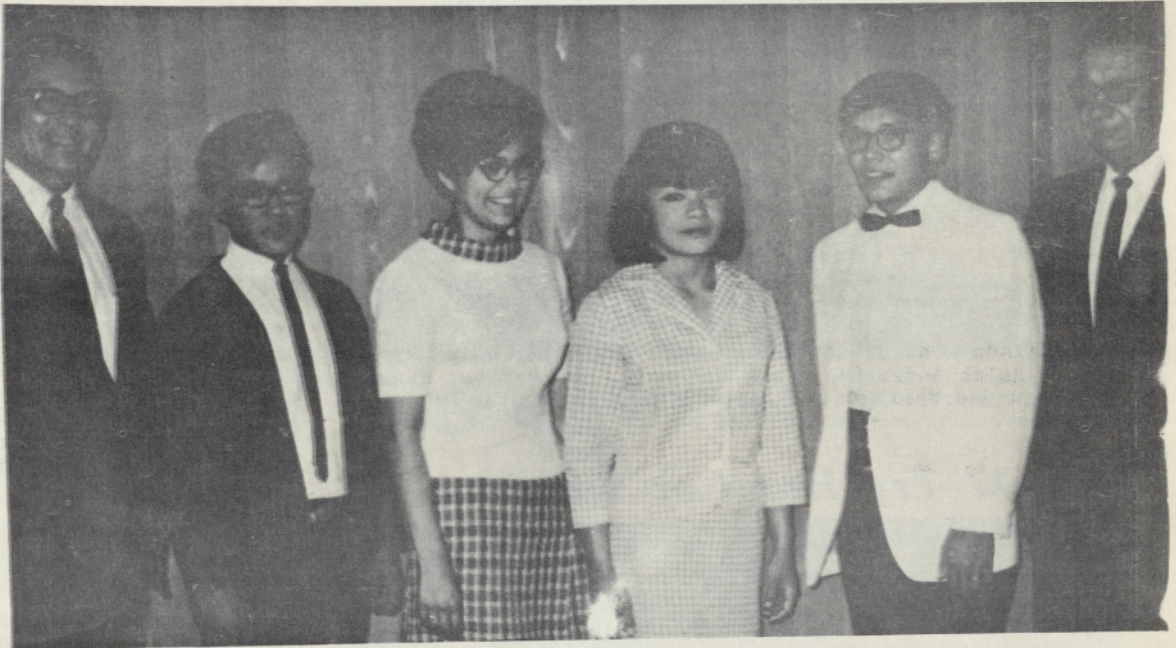


1968-69 STUDENT COUNCIL presents 'A SPECIAL EDITION'

The elected officers include a president, vice-president, secretary and treasurer, as well as representatives from each class and each dorm.

Because of the responsive manner in which the students have accepted responsibility

for governing themselves, the Student Council has found itself with more duties to assume.

The 1969 Student Council has established a loan fund from which a student who has a definite need can get some financial assistance. A fund has also been set up so the students will not have to wait for a long time to have their glasses repaired. The Council is also responsible for overseeing the Student Bank.

The Council has been instrumental in planning weekend activities, such as movies and live music for dances. Tickets for athletic and other activities are sold by the Student Council.

Referees for home games and extra bus drivers for taking the Pep Club and Pep Band to 'away' games are paid for by the Student Council.

A Student Code of Conduct was prepared and is now in use. Under the provisions of its Constitution, the Council has the advice of a faculty advisor and an advisory committee.

The Activities Planning Committee and the Curriculum Planning Committee have been active this year. The Curriculum Planning Committee met with the Supervisory Teachers recently and took part in planning the curriculum for next year by presenting the results of a survey conducted with the students.
