

TITLE-I STUDENTS USE COMPUTER INSTRUCTION



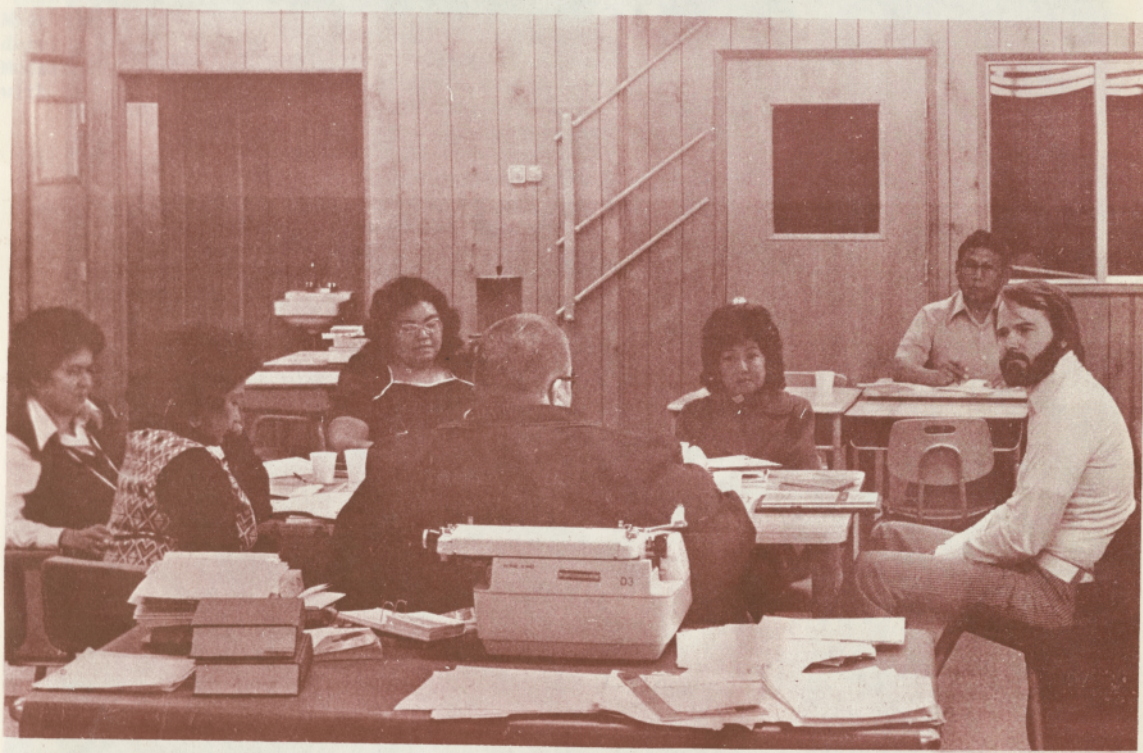
Chemawa's Title-I Parent Council made a favorable review of the present Computer Assisted Instruction Program at their Fall Meeting
