A student who commented was Mooney Frank of The Dalles, Oregon.

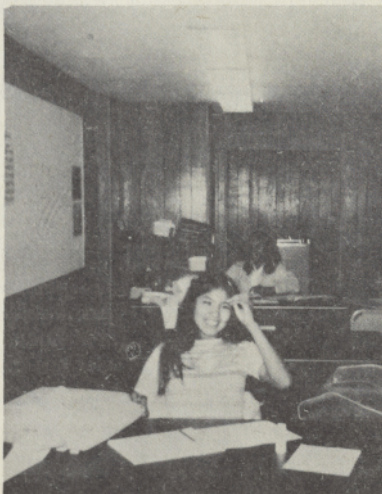
Q. How do you like Summer School?
