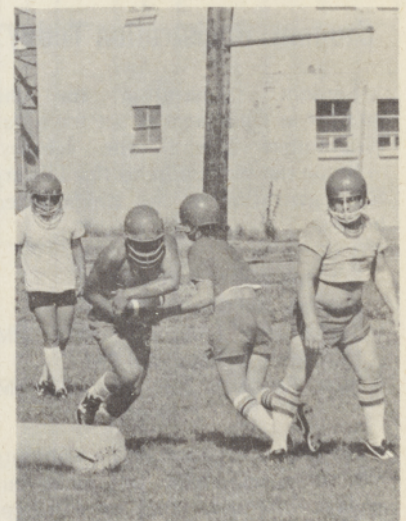
Pre-season scouting estimates based on past performance indicates that the Braves should be able to hold their own with both the Irish and the Spartans.
