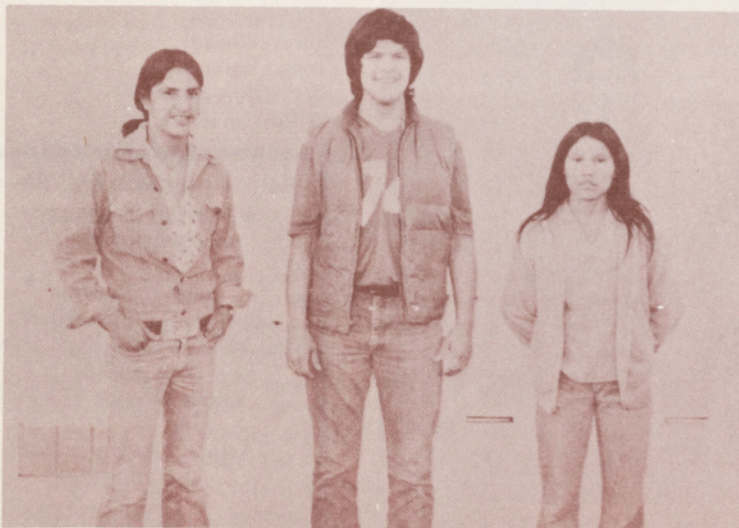
Named as honorable mention on defense were tackle Steve Filkins and halfback Mooney Frank. Frank also served as quarterback for the Braves on offense.
