Chemawa closed the 1976 Football Season with a positive footnote by smashing Colton 44 to 12. The Braves finished the season 2-7 as they also beat Santiam 12-2 for a Homecoming victory.

The Braves used a big 22 point third quarter to pad a 14-0 half time lead. Gary Brown ripped off 203 yards rushing to pave the way to victory. Brown also accounted for 12 points as he scored on a 3 yard run and ran for 2 points PATs.

Merv White figured in three touchdowns as he caught TD passes of 4 and 13 yard from Mooney Frank and also returned a fumble 5 yards for a TD.

Mooney Frank and Phil Campbell got the other Chemawa TDs on short runs of 2 and 3 yards, respectively. Lew George rounded out the Brave scoring with a 2 point conversion.

Both of Colton's touchdowns came on long plays in the fourth quarter. The Vikings got one TD on a 47 yard pass play while Tim Washam gave the crowd a thrill with a 90 yard kickoff return for the second Colton TD.

Chemawa had 11 first downs to 6 for Colton. The Braves ended up with 273 net yards while the Vikings had 167 net yards.
