Math students Joyce Wahtomy and Melitta Moses pay a visit to Trailer 9 to get a look at the new Title I computer system. The Hewlett-Packard 2000 Access Computer System has been leased and is installed on campus at Chemawa to provide computer assisted instruction for the Chemawa Title I project.

Students work at computer terminals for an hour a week in math, reading and language arts to improve their backgrounds in basic skills. The Chemawa computer instruction program is funded by Title I as a supplementary educational activity.
