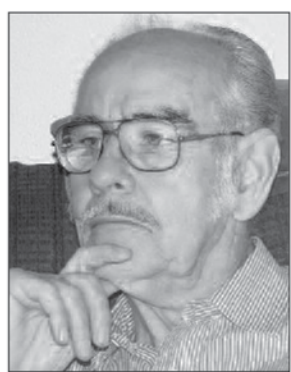

A public hearing is scheduled to receive public input on the Wasco County Soil and Water Conservation District's (SWCD) proposal to obtain loan funding to facilitate construction of a deep-water supply well to address water supply needs in the

Mosier community. Authority is granted under Oregon Revised Statutes 568.550(1)(f). Other questions may be directed to Josh Thompson, SWCD Conservation Planner, at (541) 296-6178 ext. 116. Summary: Wasco County SWCD, in partnership with Root Orchards in Mosier, Oregon,

intends to drill a deep-water supply well to address water supply needs in the Mosier community. The Root well will be drilled to approximately 1,700 feet deep with a sealing depth of approximately 1,300 feet. It is anticipated the well will be completed in the lowest aquifer in the Frenchman Springs basalt, or the upper most aquifer of the Grande Ronde basalt. Groundwater from the upper (Pomona and Priest Rapids) Columbia River Basalt Group aquifers is the primary source of water for domestic, municipal and irrigation

uses in the Mosier area. The proposed deep irrigation supply well will be drilled will be used to replace a significant portion of irrigation pumping within the upper aquifers in the watershed to remove a significant amount of demand on the upper aquifers and increase groundwater supply to Mosier Creek. The estimated project cost is \$906,910. 75% of the project costs up to \$671,724 will be reimbursed by Oregon Water Resources Department (OWRD) through their Water Project Grants and Loans program; however, loan funding is

needed to facilitate project implementation. Wasco SWCD intends to secure a long-term (30 year), 1.27%-fixed rate loan in the amount of \$300,000 from the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality Clean Water State Revolving Fund loan program. Repayment schedule: an interest-only payment within six months after the estimated Project Completion Date and thereafter semi-annual payments of principal and interest. Security: full faith and credit of Wasco County SWCD.
