Summary: Date Notice and Draft Proposed Order Issued: January 17, 2020

Proposal: Application for Site Certificate (ASC) from Bakeoven Solar, LLC (a wholly owned subsidiary of Avangrid Renewables, LLC; applicant) for a proposed 303 megawatt (MW) photovoltaic solar energy facility on approximately 2,717 acres of arable land (includes a "reasons exception" request to the statewide policy embodied in Goal 3, Agricultural Lands).

Proposed Facility Location: Wasco County, southeast of Maupin

Draft Proposed Order Review: A 39-day public comment period is now open on the draft proposed order (DPO). Additionally, a third-party hearing officer from the Oregon Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH), appointed by the Energy Facility Siting Council (EFSC), will hold a public hearing with an opportunity to submit written and oral comments on the DPO.

Description of Proposed Facility: The proposed facility, including related or supporting facilities, includes up to 303 MW of photovoltaic solar energy generation equipment to be

located on approximately 2,717 acres of arable land. Equipment includes solar modules, tracking systems, posts, cabling, inverters, transformers, above and belowground 34.5 kilovolt (kV) collection system, 11-miles of overhead 230 kV transmission line, collector substation, operations and maintenance building, 100 MW of battery storage (lithium-ion or flow), temporary and permanent access roads, 8-foot perimeter fencing and temporary laydown areas.

Location of Proposed Facility: The proposed facility would be located within a proposed 4,160 micrositing corridor, within a proposed 10,640 site boundary. The proposed site boundary is located within southeastern Wasco County, approximately 5 miles east of the City of Maupin and U.S. Highway 97; and, 5 miles south of State Highway 216. A map of the proposed facility and site boundary is included at the end of this notice. Overview: On November 4, 2019, the Oregon Department of Energy (ODOE), staff to EFSC, received a complete ASC from the applicant. The complete ASC seeks approval from EFSC to construct and operate the Bakeoven Solar Project (proposed facility).

Under Oregon law, the applicant must obtain approval of the ASC and be granted a site certificate from EFSC in order to construct and operate the proposed facility. ODOE issued a DPO on the ASC on January 17, 2020. The DPO recommends EFSC approve the ASC and issue a site certificate, subject to recommended conditions of approval. The purpose of this notice is to notify

the public of a public hearing on the DPO on Tuesday, February 25, 2020 and of an opportunity to provide comments on the DPO, extending for 39-days from January 17, 2020 through February 25, 2020.

Public Hearing and Comment Period: A public hearing on the DPO, conducted by the EFSC-appointed third-party OAH hearing officer will be conducted on Tuesday, February 25, 2020 at the Maupin Civic Center in Maupin, Oregon. The hearing will begin at 6:00 p.m. and will include a brief overview by ODOE staff on the siting process and proposed facility, followed by the hearing officer, who will provide an overview of the hearing format.

Written or oral comment may be provided at the public hearing. Written comments must be received by the comment deadline of Tuesday, February 25, 2020 at 5:00 p.m., or if submitted at the public hearing, prior to the close of the public hearing. Comments on the DPO will not be accepted after February 25, 2020, which represents the close of the record of the public hearing for the proposed facility.

EFSC Review Process: The site certificate process is a consolidated, comprehensive siting process. The applicant must demonstrate that the proposed facility meets EFSC standards established under Oregon Revised Statute (ORS) 469.501 and set forth in Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) Chapters 345, Divisions 22 and 24,

as well as all other applicable Oregon statutes, rules and standards. ODOE serves as staff to EFSC and conducts the application review process. The proposed facility is an energy facility subject to EFSC jurisdiction under the definition in ORS 469.300(11)(a)(D)(ii). As such, the proposed facility must receive approval from EFSC of a site certificate prior to construction.

To be eligible to participate in a contested case proceeding, a person must raise an issue either in person at the public hearing or in a written comment submitted on or after January 17, 2020 and received by ODOE before the record closes on February 25, 2020 (5:00 p.m. for written comments, or time at the close of the public hearing). Even if a person commented before January 17, 2020, that person must raise an issue(s), either in person at the public hearing or in writing during the comment period to participate in the contested case. For consideration in the contested case, issues raised must be within the EFSC's jurisdiction and must be raised with sufficient specificity so that EFSC, ODOE, and the applicant understand the issue being raised and are afforded an opportunity to respond to the issue. To raise an issue with sufficient specificity, a person must present facts that support the person's position on the issue. See OAR 345-015-0016(3).

Please note: All comments submitted to ODOE may be disclosed to the public, subject to Oregon Public Records Laws (ORS Chapter 192). Public comments may be available on the ODOE webpage for the Bakeoven Solar Project as an attachment to the Proposed Order, to be issued at a later date.

EFSC Decision Process: Following the public hearing and after the close of the record of the hearing on the DPO, EFSC will review the DPO and comments received on the record of the DPO public hearing during a scheduled EFSC meeting. Following its review, either at that meeting or at a subsequent meeting, EFSC will direct staff to prepare and issue a proposed order. Along with the proposed order, ODOE will issue a notice of contested case. Following the contested case proceeding, EFSC will issue a final order on the ASC.
