Belligerent Republicans.

CHICAGO, Feb. 21.—In the republican city convention today trouble arose over the credentials. Delegates armed themselves with canes and chairs and wounded each other generally and indiscriminately. The battle lasted a quarter of an hour, resulting in many bad bruises and sadly battered hats. Police interference stopped the row.

Trouble Because His Daughter's Company Stayed Too Long.

CHICAGO, Feb. 21.—William Brookman called last night on Miss Alida King, on West Twenty-second street. At 2 o'clock this morning Mr. King heard the lovers giggling in the parlor. Revolver in hand, he rushed into the room and ordered Brookman to leave. The latter not obeying promptly, King fired, but instead of hitting the young man he shot his daughter, who had rushed between the two. Miss King was wounded in the arm.

There Will Be an Abundance of Peaches in New Jersey.

FLEMINGTON, Feb. 21.—Out of 265 inquiries sent out among the largest peach growers in this vicinity, 200 substantially report that the prospects for an enormous crop next season are good. The buds were reported frozen several times, but the growers contradict the statements, and say that the buds are in a healthy condition. The blackberry crop is probably killed.

A Sympathetic Strike.

NEW YORK, Feb. 21.—The strike of the building trades in sympathy with that of the electrical wiremen, bids fair to surpass any other in the history of those organizations. It may affect nearly 100,000. So far 2000 men are out. At noon today workmen employed on the American Surety building and the addition to St. Luke's hospital quit. It was announced that work ceased this afternoon on the new clearing-house building, on Cedar street.

Gentry Stands a Good Chance of Recovering.

PHILADELPHIA, Feb. 21.—James B. Gentry, the murderer of Actress Madge Yorke, is still alive and the chances are he will recover. Two policemen are constantly on guard at the hospital, not only to prevent his escape, but to frustrate any attempt by Gentry at self-destruction.
