Weather Crop Bulletin No. 5 of the Oregon State Weather Service for Eastern Oregon.

Warm, clear weather prevailed up to Friday, when it clouded up and rain began falling, which continued until Sunday noon. The maximum temperatures ranged from 80 to 86 degrees. The minimum from 36 to 54 degrees. The rainfall amounted to .07 of an inch at The Dalles, .34 of an inch at Walla Walla and .80 at Baker City. Cooler weather has prevailed since Friday.

The rainfall was most opportune; vegetation was suffering from lack of rain and the copious showers occurring have been of the greatest benefit. More rain would be of value in Morrow, Gilliam and Sherman counties. The warm weather caused a rapid growth in all The wheat growers are much encouraged prospects are brighter for a crop for them.
