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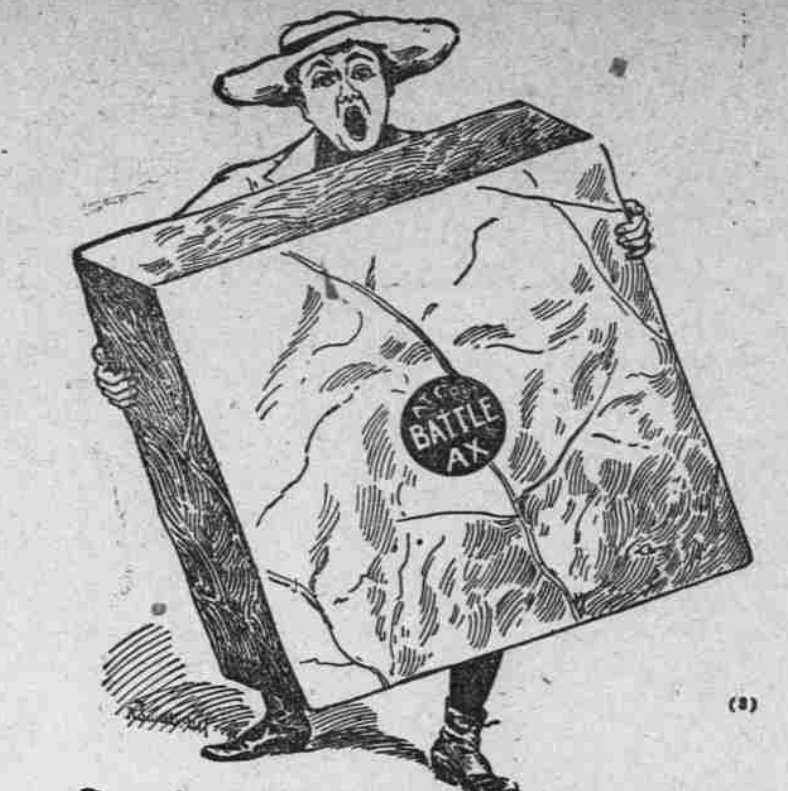

John Topar and Alice Topar, defendants.
To John Topar, of the above named defendants:
In the name of the State of Oregon:
