OKLAHOMA IS BOOMING. It May Become a State Before Either New Mexico or Arizona. Oklahoma was organized as a territory in May, 1890, a little more than seven years ago, having been cut off from the Indian territory.

The development of Oklahoma has been promoted enormously since its establishment as a territory. The railroad business has been developed largely within its borders, and the early settlers who went out in wagons, in carts and on prairie schooners have now all the facilities of modern travel.

Oklahoma is modern in some other respects. In 1896 there were more business failures in it than in all the other territories combined—more business failures in the year than in New Hampshire and Vermont together.
