DELINQUENT TAX SALE

FOR THE YEAR 1899.

By virtue of a warrant issued by the clerk of the county court of the county of Wasco, for the state of Oregon, dated the 17th of September, 1900, to me directed, commanding me to levy on the goods and chattels of the delinquent tax payers for said county, for the year 1899 thereon attached, and if none be found thereon upon the real property as set forth and described in the said delinquent tax roll, or so much thereof as shall satisfy the amount of taxes charged therein, together with the costs and expenses, I will, on

at the front door of the court house in said county, at the hour of 10 o'clock in the forenoon of said day, sell at public auction to the highest bidder for cash, subject to redemption, to satisfy said warrant, cost and accruing costs, the hereinbefore described pieces of parcels of land, having duly levied upon said pieces or parcels of land and being unable to find any goods or chattels belonging to the respective delinquents therein named.
