REVISED RULES

Oregon National Guard Makes Stringent Regulations.

gent Regulations.

PORTLAND, Dec. 16.—Complete new regulations for the Oregon National Guard, in which the model used is the regular army and many important changes are made, were announced yesterday at Guard head-quarters. The new regulations, constructed by a special board of officers in co-operation with the general staff, are intended to do away with the last of the weaknesses in military system that have long characterized the militia service.

One of the first and mose important changes is that which does away with undestrable recruits. "Runis" can no longer be received as Guardsmen, nor can men of unusual avoir-dupole. For it is prescribed that no person shall be enlisted who is less than 5 feet 4 inches nigh whose weight is less than 125 pounds. Anyona-weighing more than 190 cannot get in.

Another important provision relates to military funds. Hereatter

Another important provision re-lates to military funds. Hereafter any and all officers anniling military funds will be required to keep a cash book, so the new regulation must be vide. Every cash transaction must be entered therein, and, at the end of each quarter the account must bal-
