REVISED RULES

Oregon National Guard Makes String-
ent Regulations.

PORTLAND, Dec. 16.—Complete
new regulations for the Oregon Na-
tional Guard, in which the model
used is the regular army and many
important changes are made, were
announced yesterday at Guard head-
quarters. The new regulations, con-
structed by a special board of officers
in co-operation with the general staff,
are intended to do away with the
last of the weaknesses in military
system that have long characterized
the militia service.

One of the first and most impor-
tant changes is that which does away
with undrable recruits. "Runts"
can no longer be received as Guards-
men, nor can men of unusual avoird-
upois. For it is prescribed that no
person shall be enlisted who is less
than 5 feet 4 inches high and whose
weight is less than 125 pounds. Any-
one weighing more than 190 cannot
get in.

Another important provision re-
lates to military funds. Hereafter
any and all officers handling military
funds will be required to keep a cash
book, so the new regulation must be
vide. Every cash transaction must be
entered therein, and, at the end of
each quarter the account must bal-
ance.
