### WILL HIT THE TRAIL.

Pioneer Meeker and His Ox Team Leave for Washington.

Portland, March 15.—In an effort to induce congress to make an appropriation for the construction of suitable monuments along the "Old Oregon Trail" from the Missouri river to the Pacific coast, Ezra Meeker, pioneer trailblazer, will leave The Dalles by ox team today or tomorrow for the long journey to Washington. The aged veteran was in Portland last night fitting out his equipment for the start.

In 1906-7, Pioneer Meeker, who is 80 years of age, made the round trip to New York, marking the old trail with simple monuments reared largely with his own hands. Realizing the need of permanent signposts along the first route to the coast, Mr. Meeker undertook the larger plan of enlisting the aid of congress and rounding out his life in a final journey to Washington. A bill has been introduced in congress making an appropriation and naming a committee to have charge of its disbursement, and providing a form of marker of granite which shall be placed at such points as the committee shall designate. Mr. Meeker wants to gain the passage of this bill and will endeavor to get the co-operation of historical societies and pioneers in bringing influence to bear on eastern congressmen to vote for the measure.

Mr. Meeker will publish the story of his journey in book form under title, "The Trail that Led to Empire," publication to take place late in the year. He will take a large number of photographs along the trail for use in the book, as well as for reproduction as souvenir post-cards.

Ezra Meeker came across the continent 58 years ago by ox team. He has lived over half a century in Puyallup, just east of Tacoma, Wash. He was one of the first to grow hops in the northwest. His work of marking the old Oregon trail has occupied his time for nearly 10 years.

### HALLEY'S COMET.

Will be Brightest About April 15 and Can be Seen by Naked Eye.

Professor W. N. Ferrin of the Pacific university at Forest Grove, has contributed the following interesting data regarding Halley's comet:

"It's ephemeric for March 14 to given as R. A. 23 minutes, 26 seconds, declination 8 degrees 49 seconds N. This locates it as 6 degrees east from the equinox and 8 degrees north of the equator. As the sun on the same date is 7 degrees west from the equinox, the comet is 13 degrees distant from the sun towards the east.

"It will be almost exactly that distance above the horizon when the sun sets on March 14, and about 7 degrees north of the west point of the horizon. The comet will set about 40 minutes after the sun.

"Its approach toward the sun from day to day—chiefly due to the eastward motion of the sun—is about 7 degrees a day. On March 26 the two bodies will come together, and the comet will pass by the sun on the farther side, coming out from behind it to appear the next day west from the sun, and hence rising before in the east. After an interval of ten days or so—about April 5—it should be sufficiently bright to appear conspicuous in the morning sky."

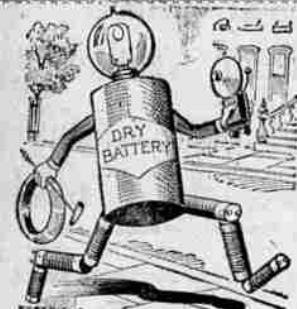
