Miss Lucy Spiker went to Grants Pass last Saturday for a visit with friends.

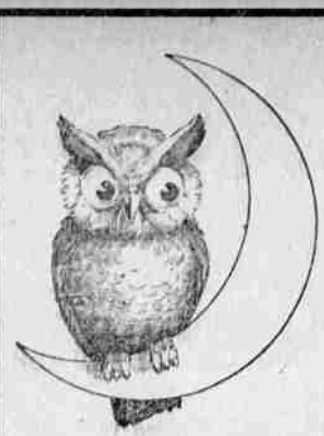
Miss Bessie Spiker and Miss Sylvia Beatty are clerking at the store of Brazel & Co.

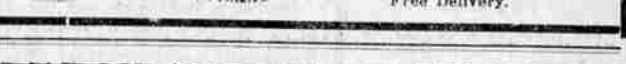
