## FIRE AT SAND POINT THE LOSS \$360,000

(Special to Evening News) SPOKANE, Wash., April 29.—Thirty million feet of lumber was burned at Sand Point, Idaho, last night. The loss is estimated at \$360,000. The lumber was the property of the Humboldt Lumber Co. The fire burned fiercely all night and was not extinguished until early this morning, the combined efforts of the fire departments at Sand Point, Pend-d'Oreille, and Kootenai being required to subdue the flames. The big planing and cutting mills of the company were saved by the heroic work of the firemen. For a time the conflagration threatened the towns of Sand Point and Kootenai, with destruction and were only saved by the combined efforts of the several fire departments.

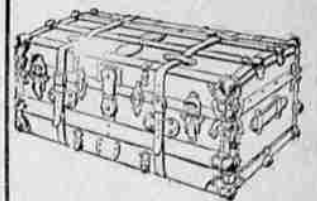

### LABOR DAY PICNIC.

Socialists Will Enjoy an Outing Sunday, May 1.

Roseburg, Oregon, April 28, 1910. Editor News:—Since the Socialist victory in Milwaukee, the twelfth largest city in the United States, much attention has turned upon the general Socialistic trend. Of course, this interest has to a certain extent been augmented by our strenuous times and high living—as well as "high cost of living." Socialist literature is becoming more in demand, and people are making more thorough investigation for themselves into social and economic questions than ever before. Many people are informing themselves on the conditions that have brought about the present stratus of affairs in the social and political realm. While others without investigation are making bold and arrogant denunciations of theories that are based on well established economic principles. Even Mr. Roosevelt, the great "discoverer of the obvious" has realized (?) quite fully the situation and seen fit to discuss to quite an extent the subject of Socialism in one of his recent addresses to a large representative body of one of the leading intellectual nations, and a nation whose prime minister and one member of the cabinet are socialists. This shows that the leading man of the world (so far as the realm of egotism is concerned) has come to realize that socialism is a thing material with which all classes will sooner or later have to contend—either pro or con.

The Socialists of this local vicinity are very enthusiastic and are showing increased interest in their movement. On next Sunday, May 1, they are to hold a Labor Day picnic in Nachter's Grove in West Roseburg. May 1 is the International Socialist Labor Day. In fact, in most of the European countries it is the general national Labor Day.

Socialists do not think any political, social or economic movement worthy of consideration unless it includes the women and their families and therefore they take great pleasure in social gatherings in which women mingle on an equal footing with men.

This picnic is not to be exclusively for socialists, but all laboring men and women are invited to attend, bringing their families, friends and baskets of luncheon.

We claim that socialism is for the laboring man and therefore ask him to investigate this subject. Mutual discussion of any political or economic question will be permitted at the picnic. If you have any question you wish to discuss along such lines, you will be welcome to do so.
