ELECTION DATES SET.

Information for the Candidate and Public in General.

The following official schedule of dates relating to the next general election and the direct nominating primaries proceeding have been given out by the Secretary of State's office. Its purpose is to inform the prospective candidate and voters. There are two tables, or schedules, one entitled "Primary nominating election dates" and the other "General election dates."

Primary nominating election dates are:

1910, August 14.
Latest date on which candidates or friends of candidates for nomination by political party (which at the last preceding general election for its candidate for representative in Congress polled at least 25 per cent of the entire vote cast for that office in the state) can file a petition for nomination under the corrupt practice act with the Secretary of State, in case such candidates wish to file cuts and arguments allowed by corrupt practice act.

Last Chance for Opponents.

August 16.
Latest date on which opponents to candidates of a political party (which at the last preceding general election for its candidate for representative in Congress polled at least 25 per cent of the entire vote cast for that office in the state) can file reasons against nominations of such candidates with the Secretary of State under the corrupt practices act.

August 22.
Latest date candidates for nominations by a political party (which at the last preceding general election for its candidate for representative in Congress polled at least 25 per cent of the entire vote cast for that office in the state) can file cuts and arguments in their favor with the Secretary of State under the corrupt practices act.

August 25.
Latest date cuts and statements for and against candidates for nomination above mentioned must be given to the state printer by Secretary of State.

Limit for All Petitions.
September 3.
Latest date on which all petitions for nominations for candidates of a political party (which at the last preceding election for its candidate for representative in Congress polled at least 25 per cent of the vote cast for that office in the state) can be filed with the Secretary of State, in case such candidates do not wish to file cuts and arguments, allowed by corrupt practices act.

Dates between which Secretary of State must arrange names and information for primary nominating election, filing one, posting one and registering one to each county clerk.

September 4 to 9.

Dates between which the state printer must deliver separate nominating campaign pamphlets to Secretary of State.

October 8—Latest date Secretary of State must deliver cuts, etc., for general election campaign pamphlets to state printer.

October 23—Date state printer must deliver all general election campaign pamphlets to Secretary of State.

October 29—Latest date Secretary of State can send out general election campaign literature.

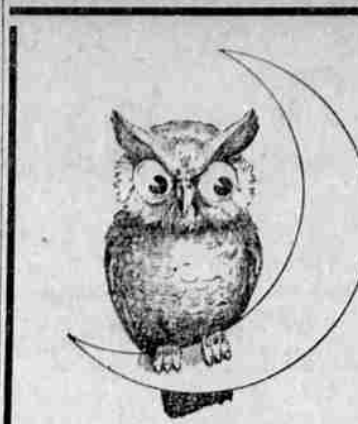
November 8—Date of general election.

November 18—Date party treasurer or any person not a candidate expending more than \$50 must file statements of receipts and expenditures with the Secretary of State—on or before.

November 25—Date candidates must file sworn statements of all moneys contributed, expended or promised by them.

December 8—Date state board must proceed to canvass votes for state and district officers—on or before.

December 8—Date state board must proceed to canvass vote on initiative and referendum measures—on or before.

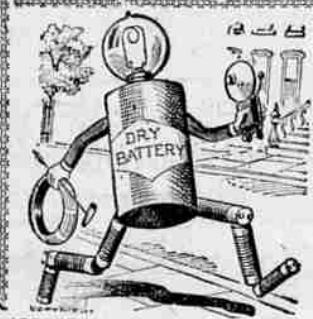
