MORTGAGE TAX IS SCORED.

Marion County Financiers Say It Has Driven out Big Loans.

SALEM, Or., July 21.—Marion county is one of the few in the state that has been assessing mortgage notes the past few years and inquiry among local bankers and capitalists develops that such assessments have driven hundreds of thousands of dollars' worth of loans away from the city.

From the fact that a tax on personally of his description would fall heavily upon the one making the loan, requests on gilledge security have been rejected repeatedly and large sums of money have been allowed to stagnate.

Financial men of responsibility say that if this system of taxation spreads throughout the state, the same conditions will be experienced all over Oregon that have been objectionable to capitalists here and that loans which are now secured in Oregon, will be refused hereafter and borrowers will go to Washington or other states, where there is no mortgage tax.

The rule has seemed to work both ways in Marion county. Not only has local capital refused to make loans of any consequence, but borrowers have gone away from the county, as it is a forgone conclusion the one holding a tax note would increase the interest sufficiently to cover the tax.

LOGGING CAMP BURNED.

Men Lost All Their Personal Effects.

ABERDEEN, Wash., July 21.—A huge forest fire that is burning the logged-off lands between Elma and Satsop, several miles east of here, yesterday afternoon reached Mack's logging camp No. 3, and in spite of the desperate efforts of the crew, the camp buildings and contents were entirely destroyed, and the men lost all their personal belongings. The total damage is not yet known. The fires so far are confined mostly to old slashings, but it is feared they will enter the green timber. The air here is dense with smoke from the forest fires, and the sun is a pall of flame.

ELOPING COUPLE ARRESTED.

Fled From Spokane to Pasco and were Caught There.

PASCO, Wash., July 21.—George Greer and Anna Nell, aged 25 and 15, respectively, a runaway couple from Medical Lake, were arrested in Pasco yesterday. The Spokane county sheriff took them back home. The couple disappeared from Medical Lake and endeavored to get married in Spokane, but could not find the Auditor's office.

From Spokane they came to this place and would have escaped had not their pictures appeared in a newspaper. Since they could produce no papers to show that they were married, the Spokane authorities were notified.

ALLEGED BOOTLEGGERS JAILED.

Included in the Aggregation is One Woman.

EUGENE, Or., July 20.—Sheriff Brown and deputies arrested six men and one woman, alleged bootleggers, here and at Springfield today. The offenders are William Bishop, Alex Gley, Frank Johnson, Harvey Jones, Clarence Beaupre, Ed Seward and Beattie Johnson. Bail was fixed at \$600, each and all except Gray are in the county jail here, because of inability to furnish same. Their trials are set for tomorrow.

TOO FAST FOR TACOMA.

TACOMA, Wash., July 20.—Inaugurating an energetic crusade against automobile scorchers, the police today served warrants on six prominent Tacoma people for violating the city speed law. The police say that 14 other arrests are to be made.

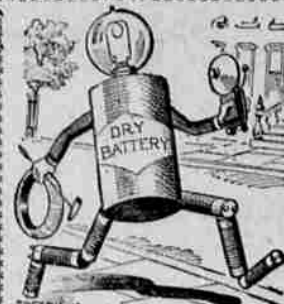
