HEALTH ORDINANCE FATHERED BY HOUCK

Is One of the Most Sweeping Ordinances Ever Passed by the Roseburg City Council—A Stringent Measure.

(Continued from Yesterday.)
Sec. 11. No person or persons shall allow the contents, filth or poisonous substance from any sink, sewer, cesspool or drain to flow out upon the street, sidewalk, or under any sidewalk or into any alley or upon any lot or grounds adjoining his or her premises.

Sec. 12. It is hereby made the duty of every owner or owners of any ditch, canal or other waterway, within the corporate limits of the city of Roseburg, Oregon, now or hereafter constructed, to cause running water in such ditch, canal or waterway, so as to prevent the fouling of water therein, or cause tile to be laid in such ditch, canal or waterway to drain the same. If tile are laid the same shall be covered to the level of the surface of the ground. Upon failure of such owner or owners to comply with either of above requests, it is hereby made the duty of the chief of police to fill such ditch, canal or waterway, or cause the same to be filled and make the cost thereof a lien against the abutting property, provided, however, that the chief of police shall first give written notice to the owner or owners of such ditch, canal or waterway, also to the owners of property abutting on such ditch, canal or waterway.

Sec. 13. It shall be unlawful for any person or person to kill or slaughter, or cause to be killed or slaughtered, within the limits of the city of Roseburg, any animal or animals, the flesh of which is sold or offered for sale or intended to be sold or offered for sale, or to erect, maintain, or use, or cause to be erected, maintained, or used within said city of Roseburg any house, shed, building, structure, yard, lot, place, block or enclosure, or other building or place as a slaughter house.

No person or persons shall, within the corporate limits of the city of Roseburg, keep or store any uncurd or green hide or hides of animals in any house, store, building, or other place where the same shall also or create a noxious or offensive smell or atmosphere, or in such manner as to become offensive to persons traveling along the public streets of said city or to owners or occupants of premises adjacent thereto.

Sec. 14. No person or persons shall offer or have for sale or deliver to any person in the city of Roseburg, any unwholesome, watered, or adulterated milk, or milk known as swill milk, or milk from cows that are fed on swill, stagnant water, garbage or other like substance, or any butter or cheese made of such milk.

Sec. 15. No person shall carry, convey or haul through or upon any street within the city of Roseburg, any fresh meats of any kind unless the same shall be securely covered by a canvass or other suitable cover, so that all meats shall be protected from dust, flies, and shall not be exposed to public view.

Sec. 16. All meat markets within the city of Roseburg, shall be kept in a good, clean and sanitary condition and no carcass or part of a carcass shall be allowed to hang on the outside of such market or on the inside thereof, in such a manner as to become contaminated by dust, dirt or flies.

Sec. 17. No person shall sell, expose for sale, or offer for sale or deliver for human food any tainted, diseased or bad meat, poultry, fish or game, or the flesh of any calf less than four weeks old when slaughtered, or any unsound, decayed or unwholesome fruit, vegetable or other market produce.

Sec. 18. No owner, lessee or manager of any meat market within the city of Roseburg, shall receive for the purpose of sale, any meat from any slaughter house, unless such slaughter house shall meet in every particular the requirement of the state law and the rules of the Oregon Board of Health, in that:

First—The killing room shall be supplied with a tight, well drained floor, with sewer connections where possible, or an approved cesspool with covered sewers where a sewerage system is not available. The walls when constructed of boards shall be cleaned and rendered fit tight, the same to be tight to a height of six feet and covered with a non-absorbent material and the remainder of said wall to be thoroughly whitewashed or painted when necessary.

Second—All rooms used for retaining hides, glue stock or by-products, shall be thoroughly drained and so situated that no offensive odors will penetrate to other apartments where meats or meat food products are handled, and all hanging floors, refrigerators and cooling rooms shall be well ventilated and kept in a thoroughly sanitary condition.

Third—Hooks, offal, racks and rails shall be kept clean and sanitary in every respect, and all offal, refuse, horns, blood, waste or by-products shall be removed once daily, and all buckets, tubs or receptacles in which they are deposited shall be cleaned and disinfected from time to time.

Fourth—Carcasses shall not be dressed with skewers, knives or other instruments that have been held in the mouth. Skewers shall be disinfected and cleaned before used again; spitting on whetstones or steels when sharpening knives shall not be allowed, and all water used in washing carcasses shall be pure and free from contamination. Wells shall be covered and so protected

that no animal contamination can gain access.

Fifth—Hogs, when kept in the vicinity of slaughter houses, shall not be allowed nearer than two hundred feet to the buildings used for killing purposes, and all waste products shall be cooked before being fed to pigs.

Any or all persons, who shall sell, expose for sale, or offer to sell to the public any meat contrary to the provisions of this section shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished as hereinafter provided.

Sec. 19. The term, person or persons, as used in this ordinance, shall include all individuals, associations, partnerships, companies or corporations.

Sec. 20. That the doing, allowing or permitting to be done, any act contrary to the provisions of this ordinance is hereby declared to be a public nuisance, and unless the owner or occupant of any place, premises, yard or lot shall abate or remove the same within forty-eight hours after receiving notice from the committee on Health and Police so to do, such owner or occupant as aforesaid shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof before the recorder's court of the city of Roseburg, shall be fined for each offense not less than five nor more than one hundred dollars, or be imprisoned in the city jail not less than two nor more than fifty days, or by both fine and imprisonment; and in case such owner or occupant neglects or refuses to abate or remove such nuisance when notified so to do, as aforesaid, the said committee on health and police of said city of Roseburg is hereby authorized to remove or abate the said nuisance as hereinafter directed, and the cost of such removal or abatement shall be made a lien on the lots or premises where such nuisance existed.

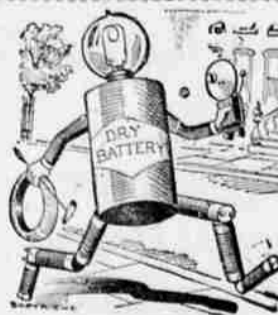
