RACE SUICIDE.

News dispatches of last week reported more than 1,000 deaths in the crowded districts of the Eastern cities within the few days the hot wave lasted, most of whom were innocent, helpless babies, says an exchange.

And yet Colonel Roosevelt scolds about "race suicide" and prates of the glory and honor that is due the man and woman who have distanced all of their neighbors in bringing children into the world without regard to how these children are to be nourished and clothed and housed and educated and in other ways given some sort of a show to come to maturity and to amount to something in this world.

Mr. Roosevelt's vapors on the subject of prolific propagation of the species has given rise, in many thoughtful minds, to the question of whether ignorance of true present day conditions, indifference regarding human suffering or simply a desire to make a continuous big noise and thereby attract attention to himself is responsible for his barbarous ideas.

Those of us who read a bit and think a little and keep our eyes open a part of the time know that under our present day, economic conditions, poverty and misery and starvation and vice are increasing at an alarming rate in the crowded districts of our cities and we know that under such conditions the birth rate is much larger than among the rich and the well to do. To bring children into the world under such conditions is little short of a crime and if Col. Roosevelt would face about and either commence trying to do something to better the economic and social conditions of the country or start preaching a doctrine of restriction as regards population it would be to his credit. However, it is worthy of note that even in the Colonel's own family his propagation ideas seem to be taken as a joke. Does Mrs. Alice Longworth hesitate about starting her own kindergarten because she fears her progeny might resemble their grand, in thought, word and action, or because she fears they might become cigarette fiends?
