FINANCIAL ADJUSTMENTS OF THE FAMILY.

Should the wife receive such funds as the husband gives, or should he hand his salary or wages to her on pay day and accept what she allows? says an exchange.

The alternative questions express the extremes of opinion and practice and roughly represent the old and the new. A moment's reflection should show that no hard-and-fast rule can be laid down to cover all cases, but that the golden rule and the rule of reason will suggest a practicable policy and a middle course for virtually all classes of husbands and wives and their conditions of household life.

It should be recognized, first of all, that the wife is a human being, the husband's equal, proud, sensitive and self-respecting. In the next place it needs to be realized that marriage is an alliance of two persons, partnership and that keeping home-making a home and rearing a family are a caring, a business and an art.

Accepting these facts, what follows?

This is the wife should be so treated in the financial affairs of the family that her self-respect will be conserved, her rights as a partner recognized, and her service to the firm receive its share of the husband's income.

The methods and degree of apportioning the family's finances are matters of detail. The adjustment of them depends on varying conditions and circumstances and on the character of husband and wife. But no wife ought to be subjected to humiliation in her financial dealings with her husband.

Satisfactory settlement of the conjugal finances would more frequently be attended if it were universally acknowledged that the wife and mother is an economic asset and has commercial value to the family. Her housekeeping and her care of the children may not be rated among "gainful occupations" but they are service and service earns and is entitled to money. Sentimentalists may consider this a sordid point of view, but ignoring the fact that the housewife is as truly an earner as the masculine breadwinner, eventuates in hurt to the finer ends of marriage. There ought to be clear understandings between husbands and wives as to the family purse and it is best that the understanding be reached before the fact.
