H. J. Ritcher has filed a suit in the circuit court against G. P. Miller in which he asks to recover the sum of \$227.75, including principal and interest, on a delinquent promissory note. The plaintiff also asks for attorney's fees in the sum of \$25. Attorney George Nether represents the plaintiff.

Miss Elsie Wetstein, who is employed at the Roseburg Soda Works, will probably lose the sight of her left eye as the result of an accident which befell her late yesterday. The young lady was washing bottles when one of their number burst with the result that a piece of the flying glass cut through the pupil of her eye. Dr. A. C. Seely is attending the patient.

John White, who is promoting an irrigation project in Southern Douglas county, returned here this afternoon after a few days spent at Riddle and Canyonville. During his recent visit East he sold the beautiful 700-acre Martin ranch, situated midway between Davis Creek and Canyonville to a wealthy Ohio banker and farmer. The newcomers are already making preparations to improve the ranch, and in preliminary will set aside 200 acres to be used in growing alfalfa.

While assisting in digging a ditch preparatory to laying sub-drains, almost directly in front of the residence of Dr. S. Hoffman, who was summoned by people who chanced to be in the vicinity at the time. Smith claims that Daley struck him with the rock, while the defendant alleges that he simply hurled the rock in order to frighten his accuser. Both men were formerly employed by the Clarke & Henry Construction Company. The prosecution will be conducted by District Attorney Geo. M. Brown.
