STILL AT LARGE.

Fugitives Elude Klamath County
Officials.

KLAMATH FALLS, Or., Oct. 5.—
Although three days have now
elapsed since F. B. Thorne, the
nurse-accomplice of Dr. Grant J. Ly-
man, made his sensational escape
from jail here, in company with four
other prisoners, none of the fugi-
tives have yet been arrested.

It is believed that Thorne has
doubled back to California, where
he will seek assistance from his
friends and may be supplied with
funds.

Bert and Fred Wilson, alleged
highway robbers and believed to have
been concerned in the holdup of a
Southern Pacific train in Cow Creek
Canyon last summer are thought
to be with Thorne. The trio may
have made for the lava beds, 40
miles south of Klamath Falls.

Jim Hill and Frank Purdy, accus-
ed of petty crimes, were trailed to
the Ambrose ranch, four miles north
of this city. Soaked and hungry, at
3 a. m. Saturday morning, they
aroused the household and hired
Mrs. Jamison to cook breakfast, for
which the younger paid in nickels
and dimes.

They told her they had
been to Klamath county fair and
were on their way back to a lumber
camp. Sheriff Barnes is in hot pur-
suit of the fugitives.

Dr. Lyman's hearing before Unit-
ed States Commissioner Richardson
has been set for this morning. A. E.
Johnson, from the Attorney-General's
office, and H. G. Darand, postoffice
inspector are both here in connection
with the charges.

Dr. Lyman now is being guarded
in a local hotel.
