ANENT THE RECALL.

Prominent Attorney Gives His Views on the Local Issue.
Editor News: In your issue of the 2nd inst., is a statement put forth in the interest of the movement to recall Judge Coke, which seems to call for a protest. Inasmuch as I was connected with the trial in which Judge Coke took the action which has given rise to the recall movement, I have heretofore refrained from taking part in the matter. In my opinion it would not be an edifying spectacle to see attorneys who had taken part in a trial in court seek to reverse the court by a recall movement, except perhaps in some flagrant case of gross incapacity, favoritism or corruption. In passing, I feel like saying that possibly the recall when wisely used will be limited to cases of the kind just mentioned. However that may be, I am not writing at present either for or against the recall of Judge Coke. That he made a mistake in his instructions to the jury in the McClaren case, I have always believed; that he acted corruptly, I have never believed. There is no evidence to justify anyone in charging Judge Coke with corruption. What I wish to refer to at present is centrally located. In a statement published on behalf of the movement to recall Judge Coke, it is said therein that a man cannot get justice except by purchase, that our judiciary is corrupt, etc. These statements are downright falsehoods, and the man who retails the same is a dangerous citizen. One is moved to ask, why could not those who desire to recall Judge Coke, go before the people on the merits of their case without making a general malicious assault upon the courts? Do they wish to absolutely distrust and forever damn the recall system while it is yet new? Perhaps they lack the discernment to see that this is what they are doing. The sensible and patriotic people of the second judicial district will hardly follow such leadership as this.
