ITALY HUMBLE

Releases Turkish Nurses and Apologizes to France.

BRITISH ROYALTY AT MALTA

Enroute Home King and Queen Stop To Receive Homage of Populace—Greeted By Thousands.

(Special to The Evening News.)
ROME, Jan. 24.—Fearing war with France the Italian government today ordered the release of the 28 Turkish nurses captured when the French merchantman liner Manouba was seized. It was officially announced here that the note to the French government explaining the position of Italy in the matter, and stating that release of the detained nurses has occurred has been forwarded. The note states that the order was made "as an act of homage to France without prejudicing the points in dispute. It is possible France may feel inclined to ask still further apology for the affront."

Subjects Greet King.
MALTA, Jan. 24.—King George and Queen Mary, homeward bound from India arrived here today on the Royal ship Medina. As a compensation for not having visited Malta on the way to the Durbar they stopped off to permit their subjects here to see them.

The picturesque harbor of La Valletta, the most easterly bulwark of Christendom in the Mediterranean was gaily beflagged. Warships under command of Admiral Sir Edmund Poo fired the royal salute as the party landed and were given a state welcome.

The king and queen held a reception for officials and noblemen at the government house.

SCHMITZ TRIAL

Court Orders Alleged Grafter Case Before Tribunal,

BELIEVES INTERVENTION SURE

Chinese Rebels Pouring Into Nanking—Trainmen Held Responsible for Death of Railway Officials.

SAN FRANCISCO, Jan. 24.—Ex-Mayor Schmitz was unexpectedly ordered to immediate trial today by Judge Lawler on the long pending graft charges, and a jury is being selected. The defense was taken by surprise. Schmitz is charged with acting in collusion with Abe Ruef, who is now serving sentence for bribery.

Intervention Soon.
SHANGHAI, Jan. 24.—Rebel reinforcements are pouring into Nanking and elaborate preparations are being made for renewal of hostilities. Relations between President Sun and Dr. Wu are still strained. Wu says peace would already have become a fact had the revolutionists acted wisely. He feels certain foreign intervention will soon follow.

Railroad Blameless.
CHICAGO, Jan. 24.—Holding Conductor Brainerd and Flagman Broecker of train No. 35, and Engineer Stuart, of train No. 3 responsible for the Kingman wreck, in which Jas. Harahan and three other railroad officials were killed, the board of inquiry reported its findings today. The railroad company is absolved from all blame.

Not Making Speeches.
NEW YORK, Jan. 24.—When invited to address the gentlemen composing the St. Louis Million Population Club at that city on February 22, at which time there will be a banquet befitting the occasion, Col. Roosevelt today said "I am not making any public speeches now," declining the invitation.
