## Mulai Hafid, Who Renounces Claims to Throne of Morocco



ANOTHER figure is added to the group of kings and dictators in exile in Europe in the person of Mulai Hafid, until lately sultan of Morocco. This potentate, probably esteeming the doubtful honor of posing as a sultan under a French protectorate less safe and pleasant than residence abroad, has formally abdicated his throne with the understanding that an allowance shall be made him by the French government. He has expressed the desire that one of his brothers succeed to the sultanate, and Mulai Yousef, who has held the rank of caliph of Fez and is friendly to France, is said to have been designated. The ex-sultan, who wrested the throne from his brother, Abd-el-Aziz, is well educated for a Moor, is a poet and has written a book. He is said to be an authority on the Moslem religion, of which he is an orthodox adherent. He also had the reputation in the early part of his reign of being a monster of cruelty.
