CHRISTMAS GIFTS.

A Party Bag That Looks Like Flower.

Ideas for needlework are so delightful and numerous this year that the woman on the lookout for Christmas suggestions has not far to go for ideas. For the girl friend nothing will make such an appeal this year as a dainty apron, for Dame Fashion has set her seal of approval upon aprons. An unusually dainty design noted recently was of white barred muslin in the regulation tea apron size, the lower edge cut in graduated scallops, the broadest and roundest scallop at the center, the two each side of this one sloping off so as to make the sides shorter than the center front. Each scallop was decorated with an oval of punch work surrounded with eyelets and each oval motif suspended from a simple vine of solid work running along their top edges and trailing gracefully up the sides of the apron several inches. The entire edge was embroidered in scallop effect, and the strings, also scalloped at the ends, had a spray of the vine and a suggestion of the eyelets.

The party bag seen in the illustration is an unusually dainty present. It resembles a flower in construction. In fact, it looks exactly like a just opened flower at the top, and at the bottom the bag has a similar decoration suggestive of the anthers.

Above the bag is a new style of ribbon trimmed garment hanger.

The Small Girl's Coat.

A distinctive feature of the coats for children is the use of belts. The latter consist of patent leather, suede or silk sashes. Most of them are put on several inches below the waist line, somewhat in Russian style. Some are in Norfolk style, and others are buttoned over the left shoulder and finished on with a belt. have the single revers and sailor collars or are in plain double breasted effect.

Corduroys and velvets are well liked and are in navy blue, brown and black for children from two to six years and in white for those from one, two and three years. Chinchillas, double faced cloths, ethelne, wool velours, heavy chevrons and boucles are shown in navy blue, brown and gray. The coat pictured is of old rose broadcloth trimmed with a dark brown fur collar. Narrow bands of the felt extend down the front. In golden brown velveteen this model would be extremely pretty and serviceable.

Chinese Crepe.

This fabric is extremely fashionable, and many pretty articles are made from it.

When it becomes soiled make a strong lather of boiling water and white soap. Allow this to cool and wash the crepe by pressing it with the hands. Rub it in salty water to set the colors and dry in the open air.

Wash the crepe as quickly as possible to prevent the colors from running.
