"MILLIONAIRE CORONER'S JURY" HOLD SCHMIDT GRAND JURY

This jury was assembled by Coro-

ner Israel S. Feinberg, for the purpose of deciding whether Hans Schmidt, the confessed slayer of Anna Ammiller should be held for the grand jury.

After brief deliberation the "millionaire" jury returned a verdict that the victim came to her death at the hands of Hans Schmidt and held him for the grand jury.

A dramatic incident took place when Coroner Feinberg suggested that unless some public spirited citizen would contribute to the funeral expenses the body would be interred in the Potter's Field. At this Schmidt stood up and flung two rosaries and several coins at the spectators.

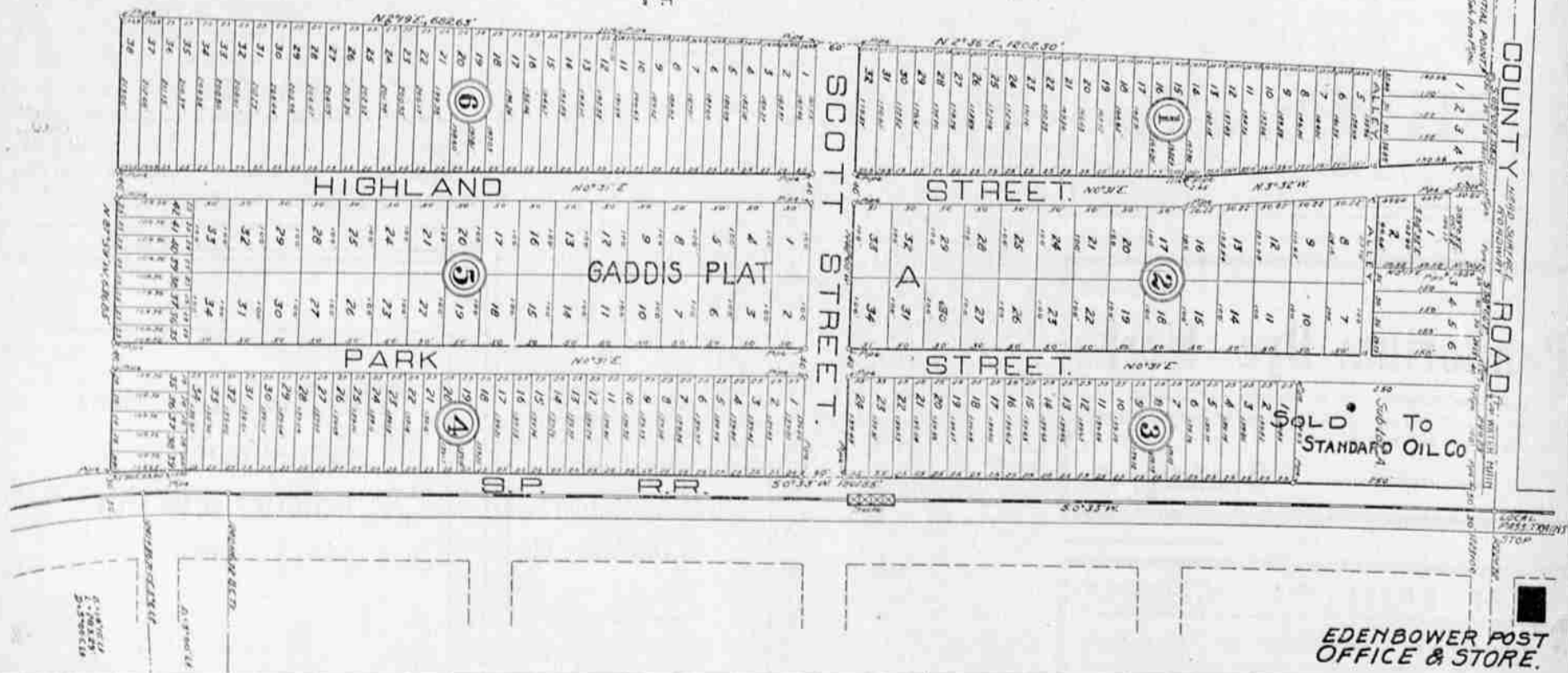
