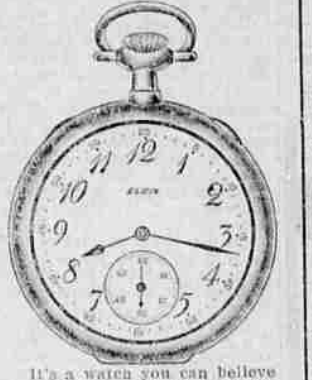

Husband and Wife

TO MEN of moderate means and men with small financial resources frequently comes this problem: The wife and mother

is taken from the home, and an unexpected and unprepared-for burden falls upon the father. No one can take the mother's place, but somebody must still perform the routine duties that children involve; and, of course, the expenses of the mother's illness and passing away, far from inconceivable, must be paid.
