A committee was appointed last night at the regular meeting of the commercial club to see what arrangements could be made with the Southern Pacific for a special train. PONY CONTEST ENDS.

Son of Dr. and Mrs. Bradburn Gets The Coveted Prize.

In a contest which was active from its start more than six months ago "Peanut," the pony which the Bellows Store Company offered as a prize, was won by George Bradburn, son of Dr. and Mrs. Bradburn. Last night at the Antlers theatre "Peanut" was shown on the stage and presented to the successful contestant. MEXICO AFFAIRS

Considered in New Light by Wilson Administration.

MAY RECOGNIZE BELLIGERENTS

This Plan May Hasten Downfall of Huerta's Dictatorship of Mexico—Lamar Forfeits Bond of \$3,000.

(Special to The Evening News.) WASHINGTON, Oct. 15.—Convicted that Provisional President Huerta has no idea of relinquishing his grip on Mexico, but that he aims to emulate ex-President Diaz, President Wilson and other government officials are admittedly considering the expediency of recognizing the Mexican rebels as belligerents. It is persistently reported here that the state department, in an unofficial communication to the constitutionalist leaders is seeking information concerning their plans for reform, and is endeavoring to learn what pledges constitutionalists are prepared to give in the interests of better government in return for at least partial recognition on the part of the United States. This will give the rebels the right to import arms from the United States, and it is believed will insure Huerta's speedy overthrow.

Lamar Forfeits Bonds.
NEW YORK, Oct. 15.—Bonds in the amount of \$3,000 were today forfeited by David Lamar, a New York broker, for failing to appear in the federal court and answer to the charge of impersonating government officials. In his testimony before the senate lobby investigating

committee, Lamar admitted impersonating senators and congressmen while talking over the telephone regarding political appointments with certain New York financiers.

Aviator Jewell Alive.
NEW YORK, Oct. 15.—Aviator Jewell, whose aeroplane was yesterday found floating in the Hackensack river, and who was believed to have lost his life, is reported by wireless messages from a steamer at sea to be alive. Jewell was supposedly picked up by the steamer yesterday, but no details of the trip are obtainable today.

DEATH LIST 513

Rescuers Risk Life to Reach Entombed Men.

SUFFRAGETTS NOT WELCOME

King and Queen Surrounded by Common Herd—Police Rescue Royal Personages from Rubbing Elbows With Suffragettes.

CARDIFF, Wales, Oct. 15.—Re-entering the Universal Mine at the risk of their lives, rescuers today established communication with 29 of the entombed men whose lives were despaired of. If these men are rescued the list of fatalities will thereby be reduced to 513. The entombed miners stated to the rescuers that fifteen of their companions had taken refuge in an adjoining chamber at the time of the explosion, but that they had been unable to get any response to signals sent them, and it was believed they were dead. The air in the shafts is very foul, and it is problematical as to how long the

imperial men can survive. Early this morning 18 miners were taken out alive and 31 bodies were recovered.

American Balloon Wins.
PARIS, Oct. 15.—The balloon Goodyear, an American entry, was today declared winner of the international race for the Bennett cup.

The Frankfurt, a German entry, landed near Point Ormon, France. All entrants have now been accounted for. The Goodyear landed in England, having covered a distance of 400 miles.
