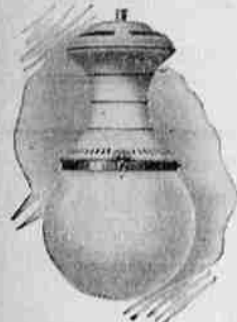

**WOMEN JURORS TO  
TRY WIFE BEATER**

California Judge Also Turns Chastising Husband's Case Over to Police Matron at Santa Monica.

SANTA MONICA, Cal., Nov. 9.—What will a jury of women do to a man charged with wife beating? The question is of serious import to Frank Feely, who will be tried in the Santa Monica Police Court Monday on a charge of chastising his wife.

Feely demanded the jury trial. Police Judge Brown gave him a real surprise by impaneling a jury of women, among them some of the best-known society and club members of the Beach City. Feely has been tried on similar charges.

The plan of demanding a jury trial always has brought acquittal. Previous juries have been composed of men and Judge Brown conceived the idea of placing the case before women, to see what their verdict would be.

This will be entirely a women's case. Judge Brown turned it over to the police matron Mrs. E. F. Leavitt, who is vested with authority of a police officer.

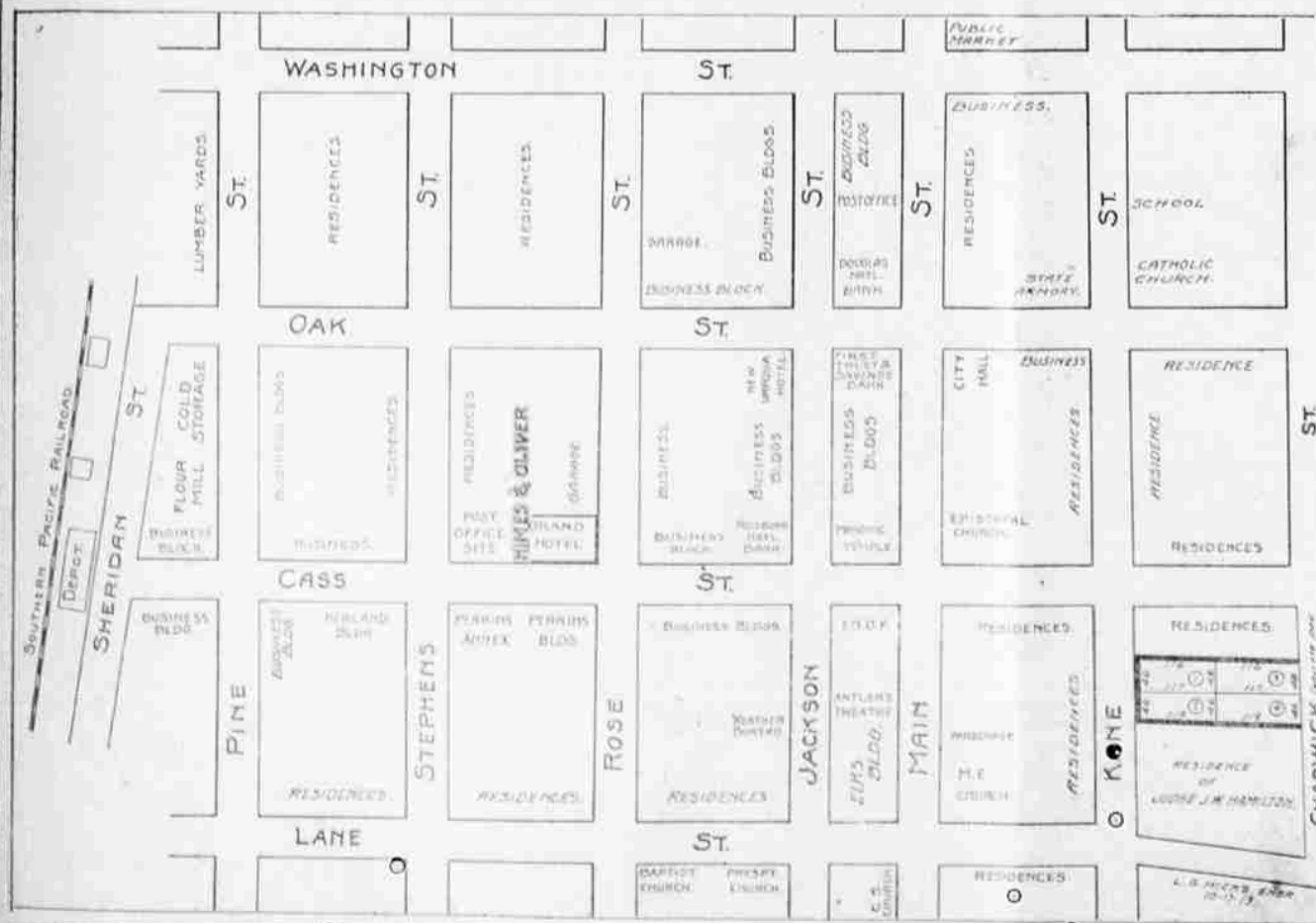

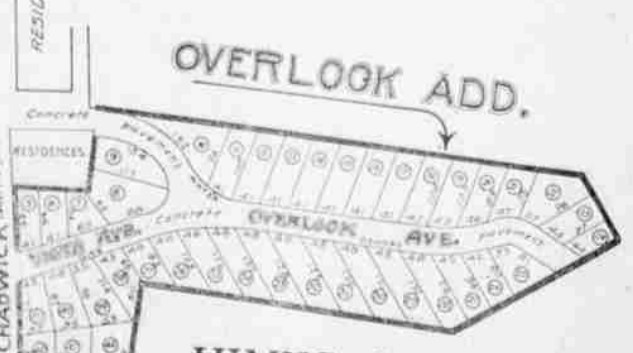
