WASHINGTON, April 15 .- The race problem, even in these days of the vexing Mexican question and the free tolls muddle, is one that is tak ing its fair share of the Capital spotlight. The appointment by President Wilson of Robert H. Terrell, a negro to judge of the district municipal court, which southern senators are opposing, served to accentuate the stir in  $\operatorname{congres}_{a}$  over the bill intro-duced in the house by representative Aswell of Louisiana, providing for the segregation of white and black government clerks under the civil service

There are today 22,540 negroes in the employ of the United States government, who draw down a total of \$12,456,760 a year. Of these ne-groes, 4,426 are in the army, 1,529 are in the navy, and 2,140 are in the various navy yards and stations. Of the rest 6,347 with an annual payroll of \$4,099,116 are employed in Washington and the remainder work in government buildings throughout the
