VILLA LEADER SAYS PRESIDENT IS RIGHT

NEW YORK, June 3.—General Villa's representative in New York, Francisco Urquidí, said he was much gratified by President Wilson's new policy towards Mexico.

"That's fine," Senor Urquidí said after reading the president's pronouncement to the Mexican leaders. "That is just what we expected from President Wilson has suggested. Mr. Frank, I might say that we—the Villa people—have tried, on more than one occasion, to do just what President Wilson has suggested. Mr. Carranza, however, is a very hard-headed man.

"Everything President Wilson sets forth is true; all right-thinking men in Mexico know that."

The military mastery of Mexico, Senor Urquidí said, would depend much upon a great battle which is now being waged around Leon, northwest of Mexico City. This battle between the Carranza and Villa troops, he said, had been in progress for eight days. More men than had fought in any other battle in Mexico's recent troubles were taking part, he said, and the victor would probably go control of the situation in the republic.
