GIRL WHO CONFESSED KILLING HER CHILD, PAROLED

PORTLAND, Ore., July 13.—Mrs. Bessie L. Fowle, who recently confessed to taking the life of the day-old child of her daughter, Harriett, 17 years old, was sentenced here yesterday by Judge W. N. Gatens in the circuit court to five years imprisonment in the penitentiary, and then released on parole to her husband. The mother of the child was released under no bond but on her honor, the court holding that the young woman should not be held until the father of the dead child should "be brought to the bar of justice and made to pay for the part he played."

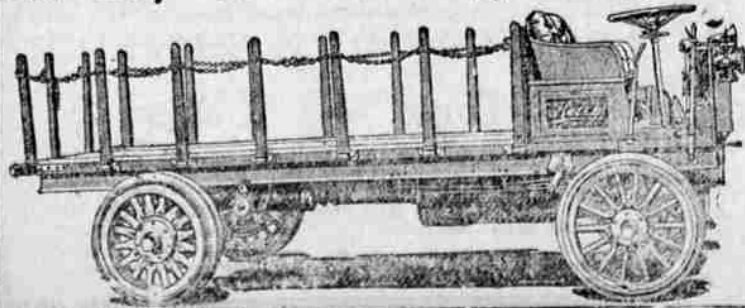
