

CHANGE IN ROAD DISTRICTS

(Continued from yesterday.)
That new Road District No. 17, Douglas County, Oregon, shall be bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

Road District No. 17.
Beginning at the Northeast corner of Twp. 29 S., R. 3 W., South 6 miles, West 2 miles, South about 1/2 mile, to the Southeast corner of Section 3, Twp. 30 S., R. 3 W., West 2 miles, South 1 mile, West 2 miles, South about 1/4 mile to the Southeast corner of Sec. 12, Twp. 30 S., R. 4 W., West about 1 1/2 miles to the Southwest corner of Sec. 11, Twp. 30 S., R. 4 W., North 1/2 mile, West 1/2 mile, North 1/2 mile, West 1/2 mile, North 1 mile to the Northeast corner of Sec. 4, Twp. 30 S., R. 4 W., West 3 miles, South to the South Umpqua River, down said stream to its intersection with the West line of Twp. 30 S., R. 5 W., at the Southwest corner of Sec. 7, West 2 miles, North 2 miles, West 4 miles, South 2 miles, West 5 miles, South 1 mile, West 1 mile, South 2 miles, West 2 miles, South 6 miles, East 14 miles, North 1 mile, East 7 miles, North 2 miles, East 11 miles, North about 3 miles to the Northwest corner of Twp. 31 S., R. 2 W., East about 2 1/2 miles to the Southeast corner of Sec. 33, Twp. 30 S., R. 2 W., North 3/4 mile, West 1/2 mile, North 1/2 mile, East 1/2 mile, North on the section line about 11 miles to the North line of Twp. 29 S., R. 2 W., West about 3 miles to the place of beginning, excepting the towns of Canyonville and Riddle.

It is further ordered that all of old Road Districts Nos. 17, 43 and 44 which are embraced in said new District No. 17, be, and same are, hereby abandoned and abolished together with the office of road supervisor in each of said road districts thereof on and after the 6th day of October, 1915.

That new Road District No. 19, Douglas County, Oregon, shall be bounded and described as follows:

Road District No. 19.
Beginning at the Northeast corner of Sec. 13, Twp. 22 S., R. 4 W., West 6 miles, North 3 miles, West 6 miles, South 1 mile, West 24 miles, South to the South boundary of Douglas County, thence easterly along said boundary to a point due south of the place of beginning, thence North to the place of beginning, excepting therefrom the City of Glendale.

It is further ordered that old road districts Nos. 19 and 45 embraced within said new district No. 19, be, and same are, hereby abandoned and abolished together with the office of road supervisor in each of said road districts thereof on and after the 6th day of October, 1915.

That new Road District No. 20, Douglas County, Oregon, shall be bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

Road District No. 20.
It is ordered that Road District No. 20 shall be and constitute the old Road District No. 20, except to eliminate therefrom the incorporated City of Drain.

That new Road District No. 24, Douglas County, Oregon, shall be bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the East quarter corner of Sec. 25, Twp. 23 S., R. 2 W., West 12 miles, South 1 1/2 miles, West 5 miles North 1 mile, West 1 mile, North 1/2 mile, West 1 mile, South 1/2 mile, West 1 mile, South 1 mile, West 2 miles, South 6 miles to Calapooia creek, down said stream to the North line of the City of

Beginning at the Northeast corner of Twp. 26 S., R. 5 W., thence West 5 miles, North 1/2 mile, West 1 mile, North 3/4 mile, West 1 mile, South 1 mile, West 1 mile, West 2 1/2 miles, South 2 miles, East 2 1/2 miles, South to the North Umpqua river, up said stream to its intersection with the South line of Sec. 11, Twp. 26 S., R. 5 W., East to the Southeast corner of Sec. 12, Twp. 26 S., R. 5 W., North 2 miles to the place of beginning.

It is further ordered that all of old Road Districts Nos. 28 and 29 embraced within the new district No. 28, be, and same are, hereby abandoned and abolished together with the office of road supervisor in each of said road districts thereof on and after the 6th day of October, 1915.

That new Road District No. 29, Douglas County, Oregon, shall be bounded as follows, to-wit:

Road District No. 29.
Town of Riddle, Douglas County, Oregon, as incorporated.

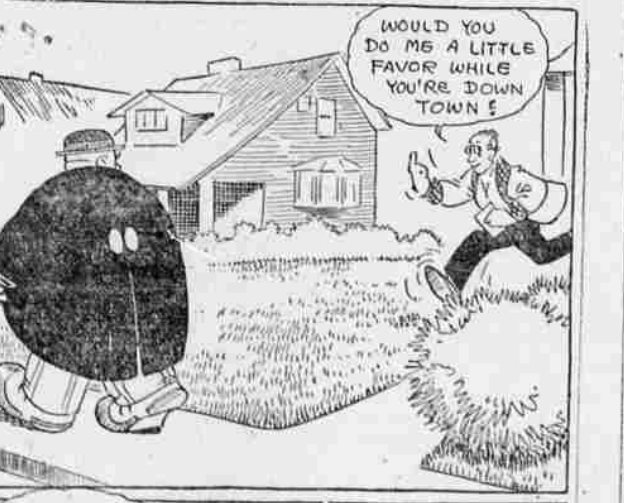
