EAST SPRING SPRAY FOR APPLE AND PEAR SCAB

The second and most important spray for the first generation of the codling moth and the last spring spray for apple and pear scab should be applied within the next few days. This is the so-called "4 or 5 weeks" spray following the calyx spray for codling moth and scab, but the approximate date varies with the season and locality.

The cool weather of the last few weeks has checked the egg development of the codling moth materially, and the recent moist weather with warm weather following will be very favorable for a late heavy infection of scab unless every portion of the surface of the fruit and foliage is protected by a thorough spraying of the following spray mixture. The lime sulphur 1-40 for apple scab may be combined with the arsenate of

lead 1 1/2 lbs. of the paste to 50 gallons, or 3/4 lb. of the powder to 50 gallons. Hot, bright weather should be avoided for the spraying of combined lime sulphur and lead arsenate because of the burning that usually results under such conditions by not spraying during the heat of the day.
