NEW YORK, July 15.—Six modern Eves of unknown identity are determined to accompany the modern Adam, Joe Knowles, when he leaves his palatial apartments here today to plunge, nude, into the woods of the Adirondack hills on another of his famous "back to nature" jaunting.

Knowles lives this way a month a year. When he goes in the only thing wrapt about him is his expression. When he comes out he is well fed on fruits, nuts and herbs and clad in a deerskin suit.

U. S. MARINES ARE FOUND FULLY PREPARED

WASHINGTON, July 14.—Living up to its reputation as the greatest single factor for peace in America, the United States Marine Corps, with the loss of a few men killed and wounded, has quietly and effectively quelled the latest revolt in Santo Domingo, and, without time lost in undue parley has forced the rebel chieftains to lay down their arms and return to peaceful pursuits, according to the late advices from Monte Christ.

United States Marines now control the entire island on which Haiti and Santo Domingo are situated, and that control was gained without serious fighting or great loss of life it is claimed, because of the thorough preparedness of the marines for the business at hand and their knowledge of the people and their ways.

CHICAGO POPULATION ESTIMATED 2,550,000

CHICAGO, July 14.—Chicago's total minor population is 596,059 according to the school census submitted to the board of education by W. L. Bodin, superintendent of compulsory education. On his basis of computation Mr. Bodin estimates the city's total population for 1916 at 2,550,000. The increase in minor population since the census of 1914 is 41,646, and that in the total population 112,474.

There are more boy babies than girls in the city. There are 117,062 boys under the age of 4 and 107,049 girls. The report says that there is an old superstition that the increase of boy babies portends war. The previous census just before the European war upheld this adage in this respect.

BIGGEST COPPER MINE SUSPENDS TO GIVE MEDALS

CALUMET, Mich., July 15.—The biggest and richest copper mine in the world, the Calumet and Hecla, suspended business today despite the enormous war boom business that's keeping all mines on the jump, to entertain its 20,000 employees and their families in commemoration of the centennial of the discovery of the rich property. Gold, silver and bronze medals were presented to 1,355 veteran employees by President Agassiz, 163 of whom have worked for the company over 20 years. Timothy O'Shea, who worked the first pit of the mine 50 years and six months ago, refuses to retire on his pension.
