This is to certify that I, Guy Cordon, Assessor for Douglas County, Oregon, by virtue of the provisions and terms of Section 3669, of Lord's Oregon Laws, as amended by an act appearing at Chapter 184 of the General Laws of Oregon for the year 1914, providing for the issuance of a certificate in duplicate, one copy of said certificate to be delivered to the County Clerk of Douglas County, Oregon, and the second copy of said certificate to be attached to the Assessment Roll of said Douglas County, Oregon, containing the assessments made by the County Assessor, as corrected and equalized by the County Board of Equalization, and also containing the assessments made and certified by the State Tax Commissioners; do hereby certify that the several amounts apportioned to be assessed upon the taxable property in Douglas County, Oregon, for the State, County, General and Special School and Road, Military, University, Town, City, Port, Fire Patrol and other purposes for which a tax has heretofore been legally levied by the County Clerk of Douglas County, Oregon, are as follows:

Exhibits from the tax rolls of Douglas County, Oregon, for the year 1916, showing the amount of taxes due the several funds; also the amount of taxes due the school and road districts and incorporated cities and towns having levied special taxes for said year.

The total value of assessed property (exclusive of the town of Yoncalla, it being exempt from the general road levy) upon which 13.5 mills is levied is \$27,731,460.
