MASCOT'S FATHER UNDER SUSPICION

Medford Tribune Gives Account of Disappearance of Alleged German Spy.

IS HEADED THIS WAY

Bought Ticket For Grants Pass Instead of New York—Is a Suspicious Character in Medford.

Medford has probably seen the last of 11-year-old 'Sergeant' Frank, erstwhile musical mascot of the seventh company, C. A. C., at Medford, and also of his father, E. Holstein, who has been under espionage there of secret service men as a German spy suspect.

The Medford Tribune has the following to say of the affair:

Holstein, who speaks broken English, first appeared here several weeks ago with the boy, and they soon appeared at the seventh company armory, where the youth's splendid work on the cornet and bugle made him a popular favorite and he was adopted as mascot.

Holstein has kept in close touch with local military affairs ever since he has been here. Last week when company I, O. N. G., of Woodburn, which is stationed on duty in Medford, removed its headquarters from the seventh company armory to the Cuthbert building, Sixth and North Central, Holstein soon afterwards rented the house on Six street, immediately in the rear of the Cuthbert building, and moved in with his family, his wife and an 18-year-old son having arrived in the city in the meantime.

It has also been learned that Holstein and 'Sergeant' Frank have been going to towns south of Medford as far as Montague, Cal., where the boy would play musical instruments in small theatres. It is claimed that this was but an excuse for Holstein to ride back and forth along the Southern Pacific railroad to

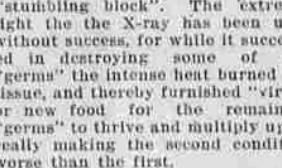

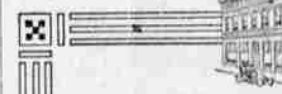
