IN ROSEBURG NEXT SATURDAY

O. A. C. & S. P. Extension Service Train Will Arrive Here Friday Evening.

LECTURES TO BE GIVEN

Valuable Information Will Be Given Concerning Back Yard and Vacant Lot Planting to Conserve Food Stuffs.

T. E. May, representing the S. P. and O. A. C. extension service, was in Roseburg last evening arranging preliminary matters in reference to the visit to this city on Saturday, April 28, of the delegation now touring the state in the interest of more extensive planting of food stuffs, and directed specially to the back yard and vacant lot gardens.

A number of representative citizens met with Mr. May at the office of Mayor Rice last evening and plans were discussed for Saturday's meeting. The train will arrive in Roseburg Friday night and will remain here all day Saturday. The armory will be secured to accommodate the public and lectures will be given both morning and afternoon. The local Honor Guard is especially urged to attend the morning lectures which will be under the supervision of two prominent lady speakers who have much valuable information to impart to this organization.

The extension service is creating wide-spread interest throughout the state in the matter of home production and much good is resulting. H. W. Strong was elected chairman of the local committee last evening which will have for its purpose the urging of all local citizens to assist in stimulating an interest in cultivating vacant lots and back-yard gardens that as many families as possible will become self-sustaining as far as possible in particular line of food stuffs.

The purpose of the train is to take to the people of the larger towns some of the latest and most helpful information on the subject now uppermost in the minds of patriotic Americans—how best to produce, preserve, and use food materials to feed their own and their allies' people. The work centers in the use of back yards and vacant lots in growing vegetables and poultry, in canning and in the substitution of cheaper, home-grown foods for high priced farm staples. Wiser selection of all food materials and greater economy in their use will be made the subjects of a great deal of the work.

An effort is being made to co-ordinate the work of the college and the railway company with that of local organizations in the districts visited, in order to secure continuous effort throughout the season. The system of work is so planned that it will neither duplicate nor interfere in any way with the other food campaigns. The personnel of the party is as follows:

Poultry production methods on small lots, C. C. Lamb; kinds of vegetables to grow and how to grow them, W. S. Brown; canning the surplus, Miss Helen Cowgill; selecting and preparing food in the home, first week, Miss Anna M. Turley; a representative of the railway company, perhaps Mr. Hinshaw for at least part of the time, and, when possible, Prof. R. D. Hetsel, director of college extension.

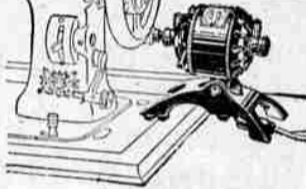
