The train will arrive in Roseburg Friday night and will remain here all day Saturday. The armory will be secured to accommodate the public and lectures will be given both morning and afternoon. The local Honor Guard is especially urged to attend the morning lectures which will be under the supervision of two prominent tady speakers which have much valuable information to import to this organization.

The extension service is creating wide-spread interest throughout the state in the matter of home production and much good is resulting. H. W.
