CHANGES IN SCHOOL WORK FOR COMING YEAR

The following self explanatory letter was received today by County School Superintendent J. P. Brown from Superintendent of Public Instruction J. A. Churchill of Salem relative to changes in school work for the coming year. After December 31, 1917, no standard high school shall accept work done on a non-standard or non-accepted secondary school, and students of such schools, before being admitted to any standard high school, must pass written examinations in those subjects in which they are not high school credits. The examinations must be conducted by the principal of the high school and the results must be filed in his office for the inspection of the superintendent of public instruction at one of his district offices. Teachers of the smaller schools, and to some the larger high schools, in Washington county, examined for the purpose of being accepted in other high schools. There may be an occasional student from a non-standard high school who is well prepared to continue his work in a standard high school, such a student, however, should be willing to meet a test in the subjects named. He will be given a principal's certificate, which will be valid for one year. During the year in which the certificate is valid, the student will be treated as a high school student.
