PUBLIC LIBRARY AT EUGENE SHORT FUNDS

That the Eugene public library has only enough money in its treasury to pay the bills for last month, and that there will be no more money coming in until spring when taxes are collected again, was stated at the city council meeting last night, when the annual report of the board was read, says the Eugene Register.

"The levy for library purposes was entirely too small," said Councilman S. S. Spencer. "The board has purchased only \$600 worth of new books during the past year, the rest of the money going for salaries and maintenance expense."

The library board, through Mr. Spencer, asked the council to provide some means whereby the expenses of the library can be met until spring. It was suggested that money in some other fund be diverted for the time being to the library fund. The question was referred to the finance committee.

DELIGHTFUL WEATHER CONDITIONS PREVAIL

The past week throughout the entire United States has been remarkable for beautiful weather, and according to reports reaching the local forecast this morning there were but two or three little showers possible. Bright sun-shiny days and cool nights have universally prevailed, and in the west temperatures have been rising during the Indian summer by ten days. Observer Wm. J. B. stated today that this morning temperatures at Seattle, Tacoma and other northern points registered 52. Roseburg the record was 56, the highest point touched during the night. Further to the south the temperatures were slightly cooler, and at Sacramento a light frost was recorded for the past two mornings. Along the coast and including Roseburg and many other localities along the coast the sun is about daylight and this fits in with the forecast well up so that the most of the day is delightful.

There have been few falls where in the month of November there is a slight storm disturbance or prevail this season. The total rainfall for November is 4.52 inches, but to date, with no indication of coming rain, the weather here has registered 4.19 inches. The ground, however, is in fairly good condition for farming operations and most field work is being done. It is not quite enough for next crop planting, but nevertheless is better than for much earlier.
