## BROCCOLI GROWERS FORMULATE PLANS

They Propose to Sell Product For Cash in Hand.

## INVESTIGATE MARKET

Will Endeavor to Sell Crop on Same Basis As Potatoes—Will Ask Market Inspector to Grade Crops.

A very lively meeting was held this afternoon of local broccoli growers at A. J. Lilburn's new store. Numerous growers related their experiences, both those who sold for cash and those who shipped on commission. Every one tended to prove that the success of the industry depends upon getting buyers at all well in the U. S. Roseburg was a early leader.

A number of points at local markets related that they had turned out large quantities of crops for sale, but could not buy for all sales because of crops being laid up in a commission basis. A. J. Lilburn gave a talk as to what to position on the transportation method of shipping.

He related how prices used to be compared at a loss and the industry never paid until growers held out for cash in hand. A group was composed of Foster Butler, I. Harrison, and E. Hellmuth, was appointed for the purpose of investigating distant areas in buying the product through the U. S. It is possible to get a number of markets interested in shipments when included on that it will be possible to ship to distant markets without the risk of having crops rot on a road.
